
Let's keep up that great math work over the summer!

Directions: Pick out the teen number cards from your deck and put it in a pile. Pull a card from the deck and use a penny/bean/piece of cereal on the corresponding number. Get 3 in a row to win.

Number Card Games!

→ **BAM!**- To play BAM!, place all of your cards in a pile. Take turns drawing a card. If you get a number, you must name it and can keep it in front of you. If you get a BAM! Card, you must put your cards back in the deck. The person with the most cards at the end of the game wins. (To make it harder, you can pick two cards at a time to add together. If you can identify the sum, you can keep the card- children might need to draw pictures to help them with this process).

→ **Feed the Monster**- For this game, you will need 20 small items (coins, cereal, small candies...). Draw a number from the deck and feed that many small items to your monster!

→ **Top It**- This is a spin on the classic game of War, which is played with two people. Divide the deck into two even piles. Flip your card over at the same time as your partner. The person with the bigger number adds all of the cards to their pile. The person with the most cards at the end of the game wins.

→ **Exercise and Count**- For this game, draw a number card and do that many exercises. Here are some exercise ideas.
